# **Coaches Development**

- All WNSL Coaches should consider obtaining their USSS L100 Certification
  - USSS Membership renewal begins May 1, 2025
  - Required to participate in trips: Junior Nationals, Canadian Nationals, NENSA
  - o Bruce is on the USSS National Faculty and can assist with the certification process

# **WNSL Fundraising**

- All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO 50/50 Sponsors.
- All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO Friends of the WNSL supporters.
- All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO Silent Auction sponsors.

# **WNSL Sponsorships & Specialty Donations**

- Bruce will begin seeking 2025-26 sponsorships, as soon as dates, venues, and race formats are finalized.
- Bruce is finalizing a specialty donation to partially fund GLD Coach(s) & Athletic Development (schools & communities) positions within the WNSL
  - Both positions report to the WNSL Administrator
  - Stipends issued based on reporting and documentation
  - o Interested individuals need to send email "letter of interest to Bruce
  - Bruce and Executive Board will evaluate applicants
  - Both positions will begin ASAP, based on securing the funds and the "letters of interest"
