### **Defining the WNSL Mission:**

- Mission: an important role that someone or some group is given to do.
- **Development:** the process in which something grows or changes and becomes more advanced.
- **Promotion:** the act of encouraging something to happen or develop.
- Opportunities: the occasions or situations which make it possible to do something.

#### What is the purpose of the WNSL mission?

• It defines a goal for a group of 18 plus teams to grow, change, and develop the league for the betterment of Wisconsin youth and junior skiers.

### What are the goals of the WNSL for 2026 and beyond?

- Throughout the past 45 years, the WNSL has gone through many changes: the number of clubs, the number of athletes, a changing Board of Directors, race formats, race organizing committees, bylaws, rules of competition, involvement with JNQ racing, Wisconsin as a part of the Great Lakes Division.

### How is the WNSL currently funded?

- WNSL Membership Fee:
  - \$50.00 per High School Teams (18)
  - \$50.00 per Middle School Teams (18)
  - \$1,800.00 is not nearly enough to support the budget of the WNSL.

### Continued - How is the WNSL currently funded?

- WNSL State Championship Race Fees
  - 2025 = \$50.00 per weekend (\$100.00 per athlete for distance + sprint weekends)
  - Participation Numbers
  - MS Boys Sprints: 55 // MS Girls Sprints: 42
    HS Boys Sprints: 93 // HS Girls Sprints: 64
  - MS Boys Distance-Pursuit: 74 // MS Girls Pursuit: 58
    HS Boys Distance-Pursuit: 103 // HS Girls Pursuit: 89
  - 2024 = \$50.00 per weekend (\$100.00 per athlete for distance + sprint weekends)
  - Participation Numbers
  - MS Boys Sprints: 68 // MS Girls Sprints: 54
    HS Boys Sprints: 134 // HS Girls Sprints: 88
    MS Boys Pursuit: 79 // MS Girls Pursuit: 69
    HS Boys Pursuit: 144 // HS Girls Pursuit: 102
  - 2023 = Fees Unknown
  - There was only TEAM Sprints, so no calculate regarding the number of athletes
  - MS Boys Pursuit: 99 // MS Girls Pursuit: 88
  - HS Boys Pursuit: 143 // HS Girls Pursuit: 105

### 2025-26 WNSL Fundraising Suggestions

- A way for all WNSL teams to take ownership of the WNSL
  - All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO 50/50 Sponsors.
  - All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO Friends of the WNSL supporters.
  - All clubs should be required to enlist at least TWO Silent Auction sponsors.

#### NOTE:

- There will not be a number or an amount on any of these funding efforts -- this is up to each team and their community. We will not have a major sponsor for 2025-26; therefore, if the WNSL wants the State Meets to continue at places like Ariens and the Birkie, all WNSL teams will need to help cover those venue expenses.
- The auction items could be as simple as a t-shirt or a hat; securing a Friends of WNSL could be a donation of \$5.00 to \$100.00; and the 50/50 sponsorship program is a benefit to a team and the WNSL -- this donation could range for \$10 to \$2000.
